A settlement has been reached in a class action lawsuit against Mason Tenders' District Council Welfare Fund, Mason Tenders' District Council Pension Fund and Mason Tenders' District Council Annuity Fund (collectively "Mason Tenders" or "Defendants") relating to cyberattack against Mason Tenders' computer systems that occurred in or around December 2021 through April 2022 (the "Data Incident"). The computer systems possibly affected by the Data Incident potentially contained personal information and/or protected health information of certain individuals. The Plaintiff claims that Mason Tenders was responsible for the Data Incident. Mason Tenders denies all of the claims.

WHO IS INCLUDED? Defendant's records show you received a notification from Mason Tenders regarding the Data Incident, and, therefore, you are included in this Settlement as a "Settlement Class Member" unless you opt out of the Settlement.

SETTLEMENT BENEFITS. The Settlement provides payments to people who submit valid claims for out-of-pocket expenses and lost time relating to the Data Incident, and for credit monitoring and identity protection services. Defendants also represents that they have adopted and implemented additional security measures following the Data Incident to further strengthen the security of its systems. The only way to receive a benefit is to file a claim. To get a Claim Form, visit the website or call 1-844-718-0382. The claim deadline is October 3, 2023.

OTHER OPTIONS. If you do nothing, you will remain in the class, you will not be eligible for benefits, and you will be bound by the decisions of the Court and give up your rights to sue Defendants for the claims resolved by this Settlement. If you would like to opt out/exclude yourself from the Settlement Class, you must mail your exclusion request, postmarked no later than September 5, 2023 to the Settlement Administrator. If you do not agree with any part of the Settlement, you must mail your objection, postmarked no later than September 5, 2023 to the Settlement Administrator.

On October 11, 2023, the Court will hold a Fairness Hearing to determine whether to approve the Settlement, Class Counsel's request for attorneys' fees and litigation expenses of up to \$175,000, and an incentive awards of \$1,500 for the Representative Plaintiff. The Motion for attorneys' fees and expenses and service awards will be posted on the website after it is filed.
